Arid Gujarat

- Farmers are advised not to apply irrigation in cotton, castor and fruit crops like ber & Pomegranate as requirement of water is already fulfilled due to heavy rainfall in the region.
- Suitable plant protection measures are advised for controlling of white fly & boll worm attack in cotton and leaf minor attack in castor.
- Farmers are also advised for timely harvesting of Sesame, Greengram, Mothbean, Clusterbean and Pearl millet at appropriate stage under irrigated condition.
- Spraying of insecticide may be taken as a precautionary measure to avoid fruit fly infestation in ber crop for getting quality fruit production.
- The sowing of mustard, Gram and Barley may be undertaken in second fort night of October.
